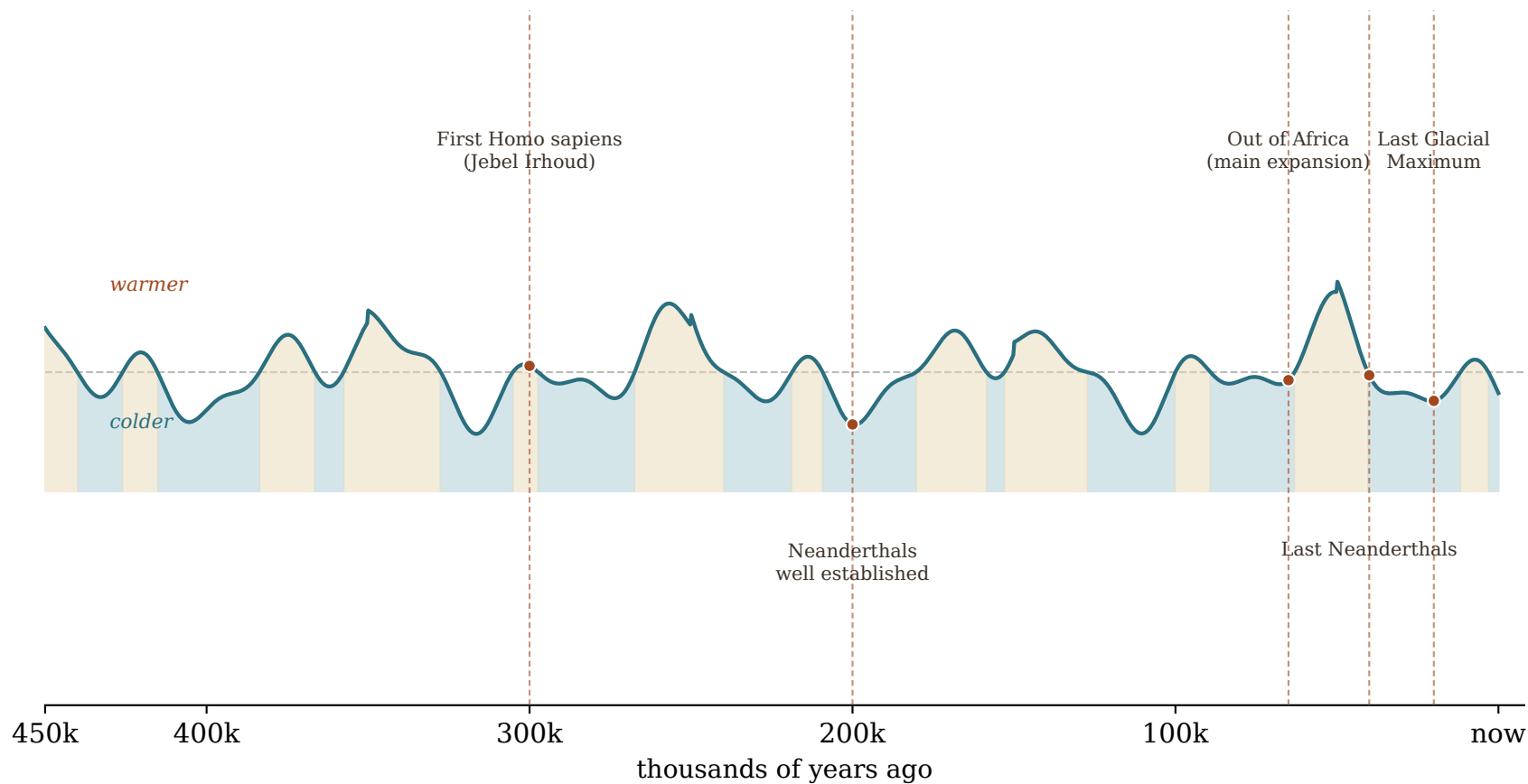


The World Kept Changing the Rules
